- 1) Be a citizen or permanent resident of Uruguay
- 2) Participant profile: At least two (2) years of telecommunication/ICT experience working for an operator or a regulator
Participants should have at least Bachelors degree in Administration, Commerce, Economics, Engineering, Law or Science
- 3) To be considered for admission, scores must be submitted from either the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or the academic International English Language Testing System (IELTS). Exceptions may be made for applicants who hold a degree from a university located in a country in which English is the official language and also the language of instruction at the university. The minimum scores for admission consideration are:
 - Academic IELTS: an overall band score of 6.0 with no individual score below 5.0
 - TOEFL: 550 on paper-based or 80 on Internet-based test
