Paper Submission

Prospective authors are invited to submit a full paper in English of no more than 8 pages including illustrations, results and references, which must be presented at the conference in English. The papers should be submitted electronically before May 15th, 2015, through the EasyChair CIARP 2015 site (<http://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=ciarp2015>). Submissions should be prepared following the instructions from Springer LNCS series. At least one author must register at full rate, and the paper must be presented by one author, in order for it to be published.
