OUTLINE OF FELLOWSHIP

The Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS) carries out programs that provide overseas researchers who have an excellent record of research achievements with an opportunity to conduct collaborative research, discussions, and opinion exchanges with researchers in Japan. These programs are intended to help advance the overseas researchers' research activities while promoting science and internationalization in Japan

FIELDS OF RESEARCH

All fields of the humanities, social sciences and natural sciences are included under this program.

Categories:

1) Postdoctoral Fellowships

a) Standard [PF01]

Purposes: To provide opportunities for young and excellent postdoctoral researchers from other countries to conduct, under the guidance of their hosts, cooperative research with leading research groups in universities and other Japanese institutions. The program allows such researchers to advance their own research while contributing to the progress of research in Japan and the counterpart countries.

b) Pathway to University Positions in Japan (Pathway) [PF03] Purposes: To provide opportunities for excellent young postdoctoral researchers from other countries to conduct, under the guidance of their hosts, cooperative research with leading research groups in universities and other Japanese institutions. The program provides a step in preparing overseas researchers to become full-time researchers at Japanese universities and other research institutions. That is, it is designed to lead to the full-time employment of overseas researchers who will play an active role in advancing their Japanese institution?s collaborative research and internationalization through such means as helping to foster globally-oriented students and faculty.

2) Invitation Fellowships

a) Long-term [IF01]:

Purposes: To invite overseas researchers with excellent records of research achievements to collaborate with Japanese colleagues in carrying out research through long-term visits.

b) Short-term [IF02]

Purposes: To invite overseas researchers with excellent records of research achievements for short-term visits to Japan and provide them opportunities for

discussions, opinion exchanges, lectures and other activities.

c) Short-term S [IF03]

To invite overseas researchers with distinguished records of research achievements to Japan for purposes corresponding to those records, and to provide them opportunities to offer advice and cooperate in research activities throughout the host institution and also to give lectures or conduct other activities at other Japanese research institutions.

TERMS OF AWARD

Standard [PF01]:

- A round-trip air ticket (based on JSPSs regulations)
- 362,000 yens per month for maintenance
- A settling-in allowance of 200,000 yens, Overseas travel insurance, etc.
- A Grant-in-Aid for Scientific Research (Tokubetsu Kenkyuin Syoure-hi) of up to 1,500,000 yens per year (total of 3,000,000 yens for two years) is available to cover cooperative research-related expenses. Application for these grants is made by the host researcher through his/her institution.

Pathway [PF03]:

- A round-trip air ticket (based on JSPSs regulations)
- 387,600 yens per month for maintenance
- A settling-in allowance of 200,000 yens, Overseas travel insurance, etc.
- A Grant-in-Aid for Scientific Research (Tokubetsu Kenkyuin Syoure-hi) of up to yens1,500,000 per year (total of yens 3,000,000 for two years) is available to cover cooperative research-related expenses. Application for these grants is made by the host researcher through his/her institution.

Long-term [IF01]:

- A round-trip air ticket (based on JSPSs regulations)
- 387,600 yens per month for maintenance
- Overseas travel insurance
- A research support allowance is available to cover cooperative research-related expenses. Application is made by the host researcher through his/her institution.

Short-term [IF02]:

- A round-trip air ticket (based on JSPSs regulations)
- 18,000 yens per month for maintenance
- Overseas travel insurance
- A research support allowance is available to cover cooperative research-related expenses. Application is made by the host researcher through his/her institution.

Short-term S [IF03]:

- A round-trip business-class air ticket (based on JSPSs regulations
- 42,000 yens per month for maintenance
- Overseas travel insurance
- A research support allowance is available to cover cooperative research-related expenses. Application is made by the host researcher through his/her institution.

Requisitos:

APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

1) For Postdoctoral Fellowships Standard [PF01], Invitation Fellowships Long-term [IF01], Short-term [IF02], Short-term S [IF03]

The applicant (host researcher) must, in principle, be a researcher who is employed full-time at a university or research institution as specified in Article 2 of the Procedure for the Handling of Grants-in-Aid for Scientific Research (Kakenhi), issued by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT). (The status of "full-time researcher" is determined by each university. Under the PF01 and PF02 fellowships, Jokyo, assistant professor, and Joshu, research assistant, are excluded.) However, there are cases when a researcher not employed in a full time position may be eligible. Such persons must be eligible to apply for a KAKENHI grant?in-aid and his/her affiliated institution must judge them able to implement the project and to provide an appropriate research environment (e.g., laboratory, equipment, personnel) for it.

Eligible host institutions specified under the above MEXT Procedure are as follows:

- 1) Universities and inter-university research institutes
- 2) MEXT-affiliated institutions engaged in research
- 3) Colleges of technology
- 4) Institutions designated by the Minister of MEXT

2) For Pathway to University Positions in Japan [PF03]

The applicant must be the head of a university or research institution which must have a clearly defined vision for achieving the internationalization of its research and education programs by promoting the employment of overseas researchers as specified in Article 2 of the Procedure for the Handling of Grants-in-Aid for Scientific Research (Kakenhi), issued by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT). The institutions are to have and initiate a plan for employing in full-time positions fellows under this fellowship upon the conclusion of their tenure. As to the type of full-time employment, it is to be coordinated between the host institution and the overseas researcher.

The host researcher must, in principle, be a researcher who is employed full-time at a university or research institution as specified in Article 2 of the Procedure for the Handling of Grants-in-Aid for Scientific Research (Kakenhi), issued by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology (MEXT). (The status of ?full-time researcher? is determined by each university. Jokyo, assistant professor, and Joshu, research assistant, are excluded.) However, there are cases when a researcher not employed in a full time position may be eligible. Such persons must be eligible to apply for a KAKENHI grant?in-aid and his/her affiliated institution must judge them able to implement the project and to provide an appropriate research environment (e.g., laboratory, equipment, personnel) for it.

Eligible host institutions include the following:

- 1) Universities and inter-university research institutes
- 2) MEXT-affiliated institutions engaged in research
- 3) Colleges of technology
- 4) Institutions designated by the Minister of MEXT

Note: The unit for submitting applications is a Japanese university or other research institution. The heads of these institutions submit the applications to JSPS. One institution may submit multiple applications.

FELLOW ELIGIBILITY

Standard [PF01]:

- 1. Be a citizen of a country that has diplomatic relations with Japan. (JSPS treats Taiwanese and Palestinian researchers in this manner.)
- 2. Hold a doctorate degree when the Fellowship goes into effect, which must have been received on or after April 2, 2010, or be scheduled to receive a doctorate degree before the Fellowship goes into effect.

Note: Those who have previously been awarded a fellowship under the JSPS Postdoctoral Fellowship Program for Foreign Researchers (excluding the Postdoctoral Fellowship Program (Short-term) for North American and European Researchers and Summer Program) are not eligible.

Pathway [PF03]:

- 1. Be a citizen of a country that has diplomatic relations with Japan (JSPS treats Taiwanese and Palestinian researchers in this manner.)
- 2. Hold a doctorate degree when the Fellowship goes into effect, which must have been received on or after April 2, 2006, or be scheduled to receive a doctorate degree before the Fellowship goes into effect.
- 3. Have a desire to continue engaging in research and education at the host institution in a full-time employment capacity.

Note: Those who have previously been awarded a fellowship under this JSPS Postdoctoral Fellowship Program (Pathway) are not eligible.

Long-term [IF01]: As a rule, researchers who hold a full-time position in an overseas research institution and satisfy the following requirements:

- 1. Be a citizen or a permanent resident of a country that has diplomatic relations with Japan (JSPS treats Taiwanese and Palestinian researchers in this manner). To be eligible, researchers of Japanese nationality residing overseas must have lived in the other country for at least 10 years and been actively engaged in research in that country throughout the period.
- 2. Overseas researchers in a position equivalent to a university professor, associate professor or assistant professor in Japan as of 1 April 2016.
- 3. Overseas researchers who do not have above-mentioned careers but received their doctorate degree prior to six years or more as of 1 April 2016 and are continuing to do research in a university or non-profit research institution

Short-term [IF02]: As a rule, researchers who hold full-time positions in an overseas research institution and satisfy the following requirements:

- 1. Be a citizen or a permanent resident of a country that has diplomatic relations with Japan (JSPS treats Taiwanese and Palestinian researchers in this manner). To be eligible, researchers of Japanese nationality residing overseas must have lived in the other country for at least 10 years and been actively engaged in research in that country throughout the period.
- 2. Overseas researchers in a position equivalent to a university professor or associate professor as of 1 April 2016.
- 3. Overseas researchers with an excellent record of research achievements

Short-term S [IF03]:

- 1. Be a citizen or a permanent resident of a country that has diplomatic relations with Japan (JSPS treats Taiwanese and Palestinian researchers in this manner). To be eligible, researchers of Japanese nationality residing overseas must have lived in the other country for at least 10 years and been actively engaged in research in that country throughout the period.
- 2. Overseas researchers who are Nobel laureates or recipients of similarly high-level international prizes with exceptionally outstanding records of research achievements and who currently occupy a leading position in their subject field.
